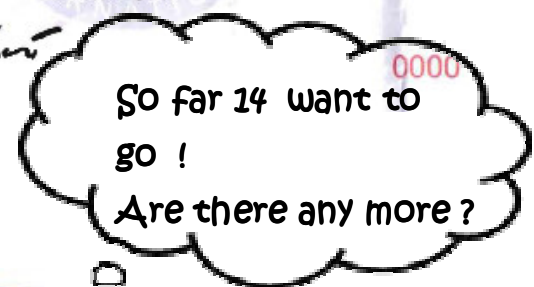

President Clyde opened the meeting welcoming all the members wearing their Hats for Rotary Health Hat Week.

PE John Gatt informed the club that a successful Rotary Presentation and BBQ was held at the Nillumbik Volunteers Expo on Thursday with seven members attending.

Greg Adams informed members that there were some hard copies of Alan's Anecdotes on the table at the front.

Chairman David Palermo introduced the speaker, David Shave, from the Zaidee Foundation.

Zaidee Rose Alexander Turner- aged 7 years and 22 days died suddenly on 2nd December 2004 from a burst blood vessel in her brain. She was a registered Organ and Tissue donor and as a result Zaidee donated her Organs and Tissues as were her wishes at the time.

Zaidee was the only child in Victoria under the age of 16 years and one of the youngest Australians to donate her organs and tissues in 2004.

Since February 2006 the Foundation has been selling Zaidee's Rainbow Shoe laces nationally to raise awareness of organ & tissue donation & transplant

Zaidee's Rainbow Foundation aims to ensure every Australian requiring a transplant will receive one and strives to increase the number of people who honor the wishes of their loved ones to donate their organs and tissues.

The Club bought 30 pairs of shoelaces, one for each member with a few spare.

The funds raised from the Expo BBQ was added to the Hat donation and \$150 was raised for Hat Day (Australian Rotary Health)

RDA develops abilities and enriches lives through specialised programs and relationships with horses



RDA operates within the Diamond Valley Special School located in Greensborough. We were asked to put this activity, the mounting and dismounting under a roof.



What's this shed about ? .

Description 9.0 x 6.0 Flat roof sloping from 3.6 to 3.0 on the low side. Roof structure is C200/1.5 C section purlins and columns are 75x75x3 Gal RHS.

The rear wall is clad for 9.0 Mt x 3.0 high. There is also a fully enclosed section 6.0 x 2.8 with a roller door at each end. 1 roof sheet will be polycarbonate for light into the enclosed room.

Colorbond walls in Trimdek 0.47 TCT Sandbank, Trimline Gutters & 100x50 DP in Cottage Green and the roof will be in Corrugated 0.47 TCT Manor Red.

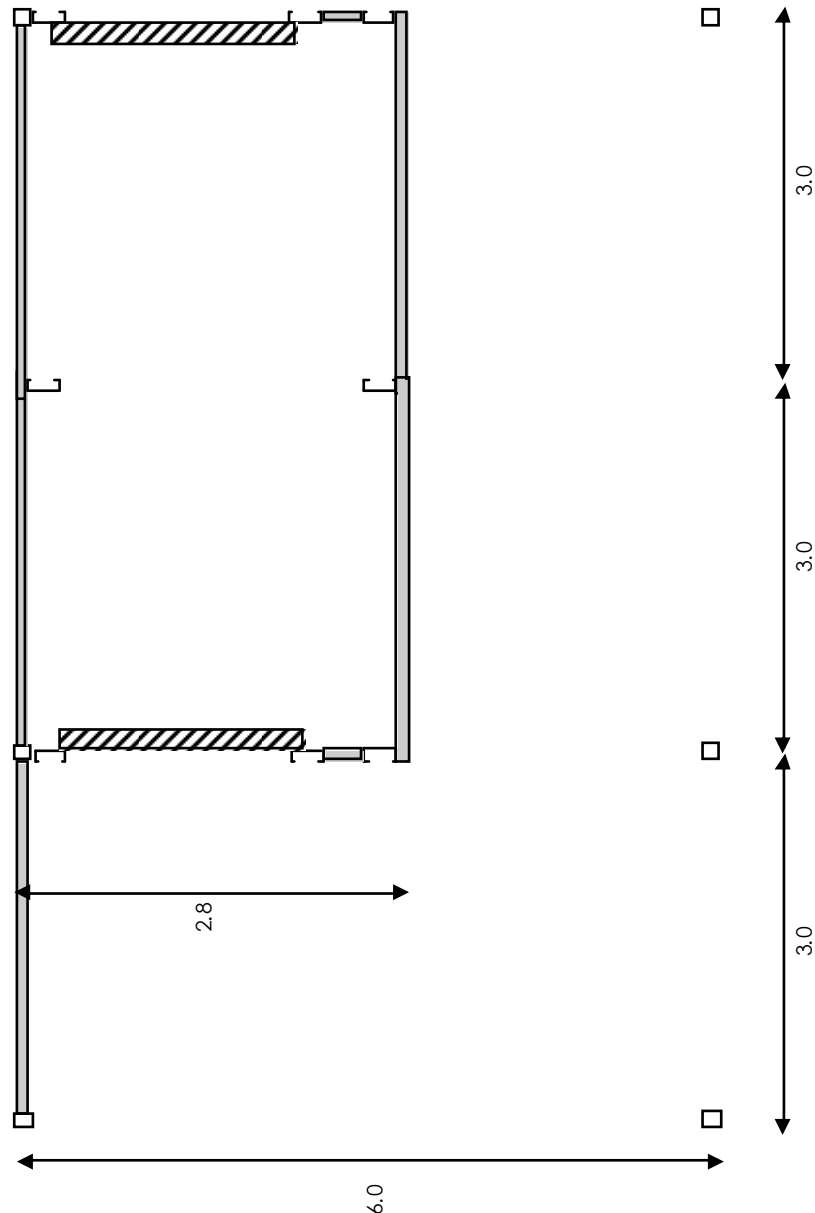
Materials \$ 6500 (inc delivery)

Footing pads \$ 750 (inc post hole digger & concrete)

Labour \$ 1050 (1 x builder for 3 days – we provide the extra labour required)

Total \$8250 (inc GST)

We should probably allow for the 17mm structural ply that is to be screwed onto the walls inside the enclosed area for hanging bridles etc. 2400 x 1200 sheets are about \$60 each. Depending on their layout – max 17 sheets needed. About \$1200 inc. the fixings.

HEALTH: Check for cancer

PEOPLE aged 40 and over are urged to check themselves for bowel cancer before a cut-price early detection window closes.

Rotary's annual Victoria-wide bowel cancer early-detection program will close on May 31.

People are encouraged to purchase a test kit for \$6 at participating pharmacies and potentially save their lives through early detection of the disease.

The Bowelscan kits are made available through Rotary for the month of May each year.

The program has already saved lives, when the disease has been caught in its early stages.

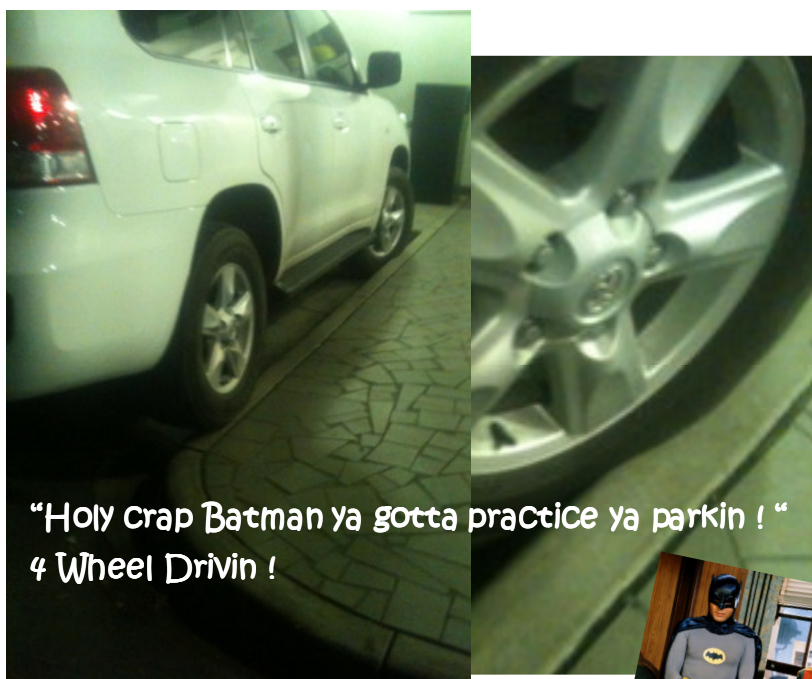
