Dear Counsellor,

The District Youth Exchange Committee has decided to replace the annual Regional Tour for Inbound students with a 10 day / 9 night stay at the Mittagundi Camp. The District Committee expects ALL Inbound students to attend.

Why?

There are several reasons which include:

- The Regional Tour was becoming quite expensive for the students 5-7 days (\$750)
- Many of our Inbounds had already visited some of the places that the Regional Tour visited with their Host families
- The Regional Tour was a huge task and commitment for several of the Committee members who had to drive the bus, supervise and care for the students and purchase all food and then cook!
- Last year only seven students were interested in attending the Regional Tour and this required 3 Committee members to be present (a bus driver, supervisor and a female leader)
- The Regional Tour involved long days of bus travel (up to 7 hours at a time)

After much discussion and research the Committee decided to provide a uniquely Australia bush experience utilising the Mittagundi camps program. Modelled on the famous Timber Top experience Mittagundi has been running since 1978. The camp site is 40kms east of Falls Creek and houses a 1900's pioneer style farm. The young folk are challenged to experience life without modern gadgets, make-up, time, electricity and yes, mobile phones! Activities include: milking the cows, chopping wood, cooking, harvesting vegetables, blacksmithing, hiking in the high plains, overnight camping in tents and abseiling.

It is expected that all Inbound students will attend this camp and we are asking Clubs to support this initiative by your District committee and the students. There are a few vacancies for outbound students to join the camp also. District Coordinators will contact the inbound student's parents advising them of this camp and its cost, it would be appreciated if your club could make payment on behalf of the student and recoup the cost from the student's family. Please contact us should any problems regarding payment occurs.
